| 1977 | FISC is formed under the name MSSC - Mutual Savings Service Corporation. Major services are auditing, marketing, purchasing and training for the seven Maine mutual savings banks that own MSSC. A current owner, Norway Savings Bank, is one of the original owners. | 1999 | FISC operations expand to 35,000 square feet. |
| 1980 | FISC owners are the first in Maine to introduce debit cards. The debit card is called InstaCard, which FISC encodes and embosses. A current owner, Androscoggin Bank, becomes an owner. | 2000 | FISC introduces lockbox processing and caging services. |
| 1981 | FISC begins statement rendering services. | 2000 | FISC begins offering eStatements. |
| 1982 | FISC begins item processing services and moves to its current location in Lewiston, Maine. | 2003 | FISC develops new loan servicing software, Compass. |
| 1983 | FISC begins servicing student loans. | 2003 | Core item processing technology is upgraded for Check 21 and power encode. |
| 1985 | Name changes to Financial Institutions Service Corporation. | 2004 | Name changes to FISC Solutions. |
| 1987 | FISC introduces P.S. Printing services. | 2006 | FISC introduces remote deposit capture, image exchange, ARC, electronic lockbox, and electronic bill payment and presentment. |
| 1995 | FISC is one of the first service bureaus in the country to offer image statements. | 2006 | Portsmouth, NH office opens. |
| 1997 | FISC is one of the first companies in the country to offer online access to check images through the Internet. | 2007 | FISC celebrates 30 years of service and launches newly designed website. |
| 1998 | FISC creates The Maine Advantage Education Loan Program. The program offers Federal Family Education Loans (FFELP). | 2008 | FISC upgrades statement processing software to offer Intelligent Mail Barcode, enhanced postal service and statement design options. |
| | | 2008 | FISC partners with WB Mason to offer free storage and free shipping of printed items through P.S. Printing. |
